

SERVICE PRIVACY POLICY

1. General information.

1. The Operator of the Service is **Pharma2pharma Sp. z o.o.**; address of the main place of business: ul. Kludyny 38/117, 01-684 Warsaw, registered in the Central Registration and Information on Business, with Tax Identification Number (NIP): 5272531180, REGON number: 140861765.
2. **Pharma2pharma Sp. z o.o.**, address of the main place of business: ul. Kludyny 38/117, 01-684 Warsaw Central Registration and Information on Business, with NIP number: 5272531180, REGON number: 140861765, is the Controller of the Service personal data database.
3. The Service performs the functions of obtaining information about users and their behaviour in the following way:
 1. Through information voluntarily entered in the forms.
 2. By storing cookies on terminal equipment.
 3. By collecting web server logs by the hosting operator - home.pl

2. Information in the forms.

1. The Service collects information provided voluntarily by the user.
2. The Service may also store information about connection parameters (time stamp, IP address).
3. The data in the form shall not be made available to third parties otherwise than upon consent of the user.
4. The data provided in the form may constitute a set of potential customers registered

by the Operator of the Service in the register kept by the General Inspector for Personal Data Protection.

5. The data provided in the form shall be processed for the purpose resulting from the function of a particular form, e.g.

in order to process the Service request or commercial contact.

6. The data provided in the forms may be conveyed to providers of certain technical services - this applies in particular to the transmission of information on the holder of a registered domain to entities that are operators of Internet domains (mainly the Research and Academy Computer Network - NASK), payment services or other entities with whom

the Operator of the Service cooperates in this respect.

3. Information about cookies.

1. The Service uses cookies.
2. Cookies are IT data, in particular text files that are stored in the terminal device of the Service User and Office are intended for the use of the Service's websites. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they come, the time they are stored on the terminal equipment and a unique number.
3. The entity placing cookies on the terminal device of the Service User and obtaining access to them is the Service Operator.

4. The cookies are used for the following purposes:
 1. generation of statistics that help understand how Service Users use websites, which makes it possible to improve their structure and content;
 2. maintaining the Service User session (after logging in), thanks to which the User does not have to re-enter his or her login and password on each subpage of the Service;
 3. defining the user's profile for the purpose of displaying tailored material on advertising networks, in particular Google networks.
5. Within the Service, the following two basic cookie types are applied: session cookies and

persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary files which are stored in the User's terminal device until logging out, leaving the Service or switching off the software (Internet browser). Persistent cookies are stored in the User's terminal device for a period of time defined in the parameters of cookies or until the User removes them.

6. Software for web browsing (web browser) usually by default allows storing cookies in the User's terminal device. Users of the Service can change settings in this respect. Web browsers allow to delete cookies. It is also possible to automatically block cookies. Please refer to the browser's help or documentation for details.
7. Restrictions on the use of cookies may affect certain functionalities available on the Service.
8. Cookies placed in the Service User's terminal device and used for a long time may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the Service Operator.

10. Cookies can be used by advertising networks, including Google, to display advertisements that match the way the user uses the Service. For this purpose, they can store information about the user's navigation path or the time of staying on a given page.

4. Server logs.

1. Information about some of the user's behaviours is stored in logs on the server layer. This data is used exclusively for the administration of the Service and to ensure the most efficient operation of the hosting services provided.
2. The resources being viewed are identified by their URLs. In addition, the following data may be saved:
 1. Query time,
 2. Reply time,
 3. Name of the client - identification via the HTTP protocol,

4. Information on errors that occurred during the execution of HTTP transactions,
 5. URL of the page previously visited by the user (referrer link) - in the case of a link to the Service,
 6. Information about the user's browser,
 7. Information about the IP address.
3. The above data shall not be associated with any particular person browsing websites.
 4. The above data shall only be used for the purpose of administration of the server.

5. Data access.

1. The data shall be made available to external parties only within the limits of the law.
2. Data enabling identification of a natural person shall be provided with the consent of that person.
3. The Operator may be obliged to provide information collected by the Service to authorised bodies on the basis of lawful tasks performed by them.

6. Cookie management - how to give and withdraw consent in practice?

1. If you do not want to receive cookies, you can change your browser settings. We advise you that disabling the use of cookies necessary for authentication, security, and maintenance of user preferences may render it difficult to use the Service, and in extreme cases prevent it altogether.
